Reasons not to vote for John Gartley, head of the Aberdeen Republican team.

As an Aberdeen Township Councilman, from 1994–1997, he:

- Was the only council member to vote against the road improvement program and that was *after his road was paved.*
- Allowed an \$800,000 plus NJ Green Acres low interest loan to expire. This prevented the Township from acquiring additional land for open space and parkland.
- Appointed a Republican friend to the Township Council, in violation of existing law. NJ courts found the appointment improper and illegal.

Since 1997, he has run for Aberdeen Township Council twice and Aberdeen voters have rejected him twice for good reasons that haven't changed.

Vote no for Gartley and the Republican team.
